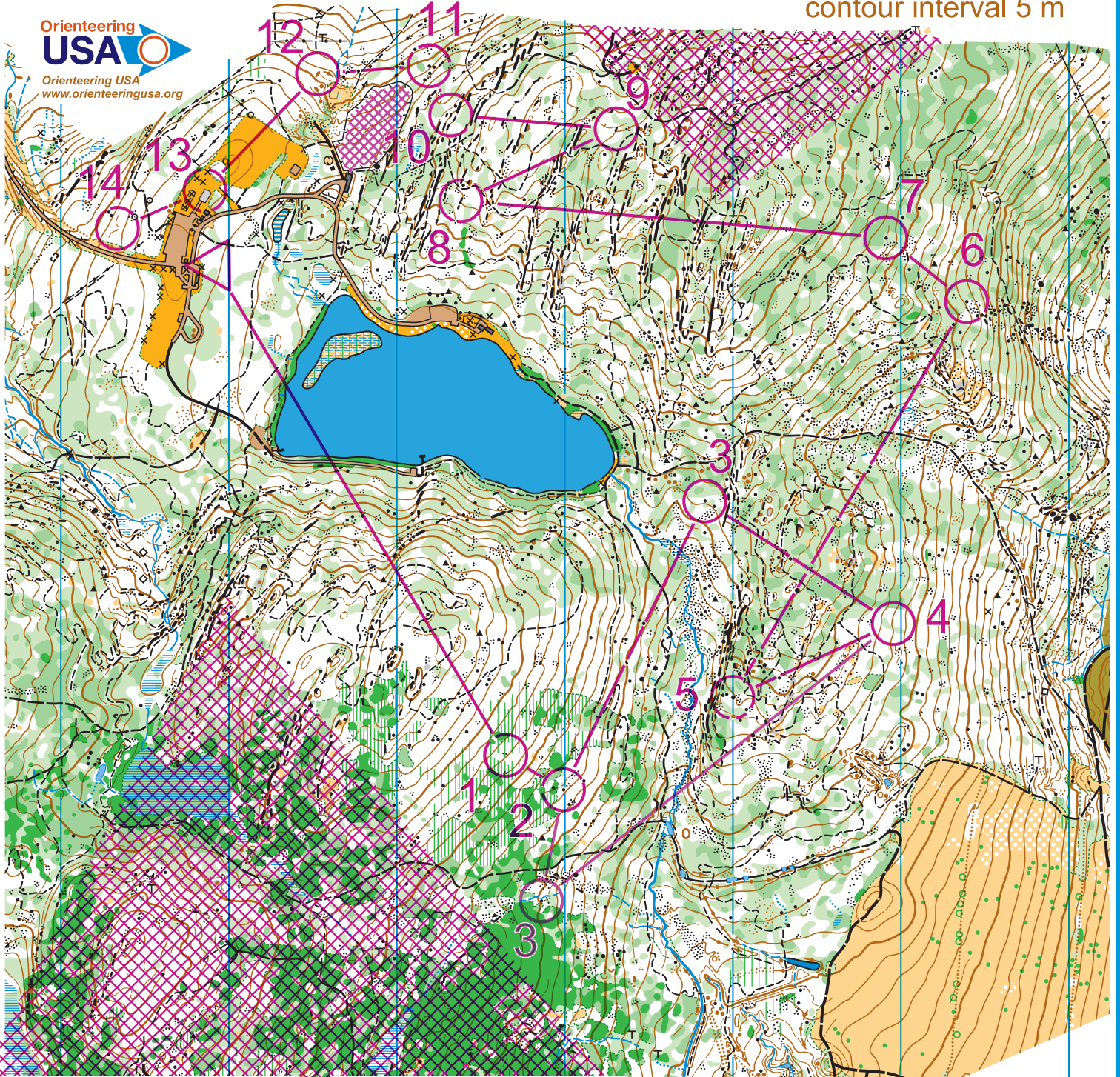


Orienteering map of Merli-Sarnoski Park

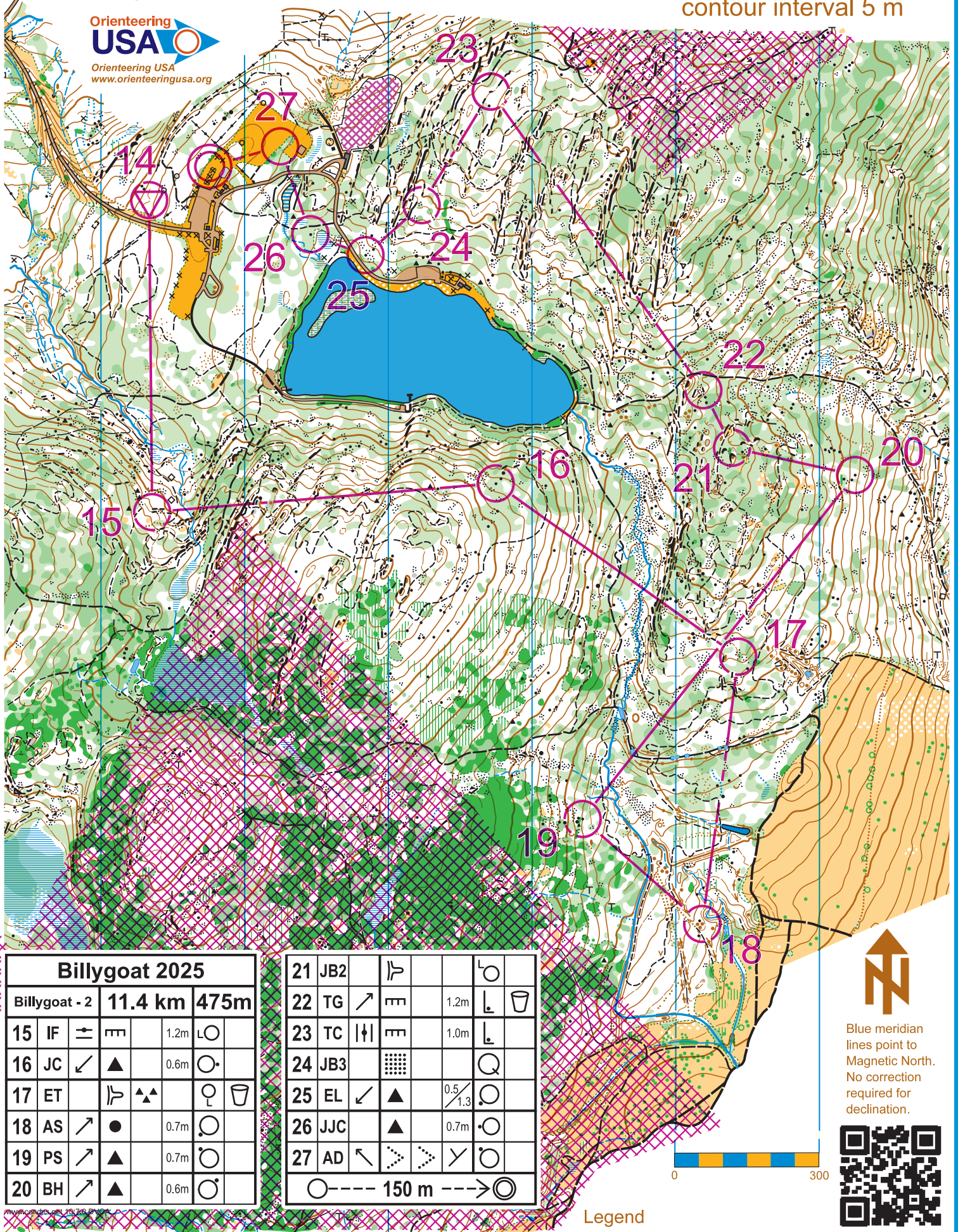
